These voicings will work for most sazz oriented blues tunes in C. These are all seventh chords, with no extensions (9ts, 11ths, and 13ths). Unlike sazz standards from the American song book, which typically use major seventh and major sixth chords as tonic (17) and subdominant chords (177), the blues uses the dominant seventh chord quality for its tonic and subdominant chords.
